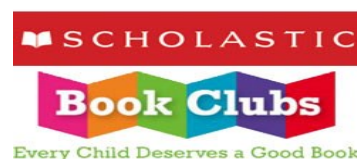
If your child is attending the Canberra excursion please complete and return all permission notes and medical forms by this Friday, 9 June. Final payment is required by Friday, 23 June.

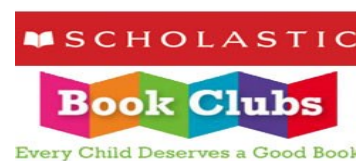
