It was an outstanding showcase of the variety of learning experiences our students engage with on a daily basis.

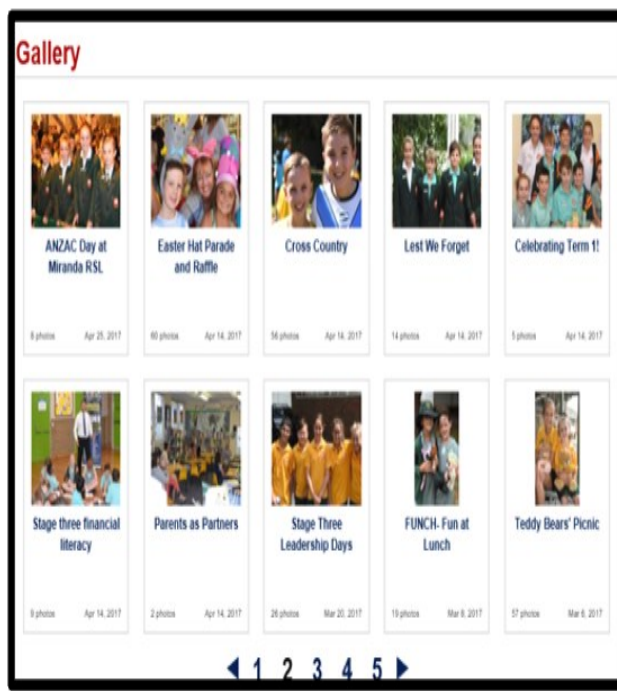
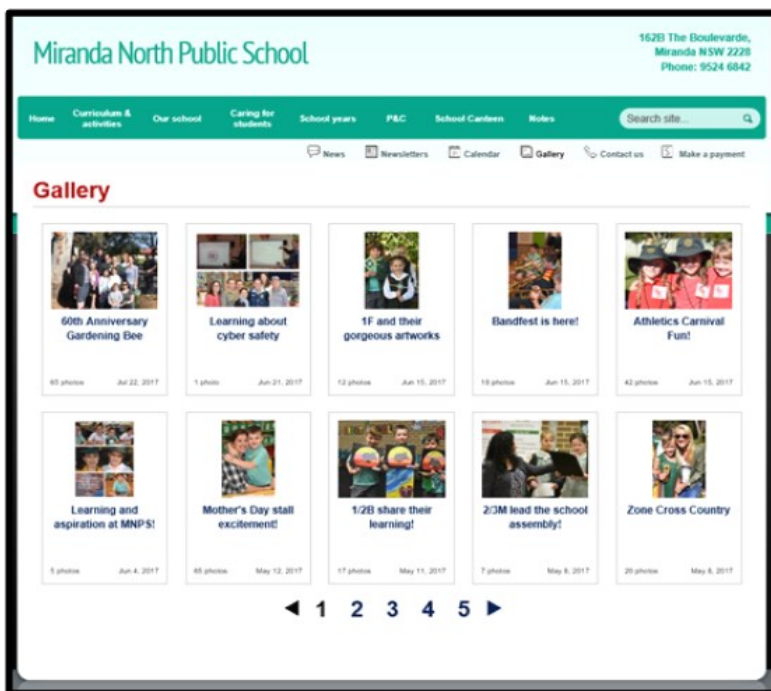

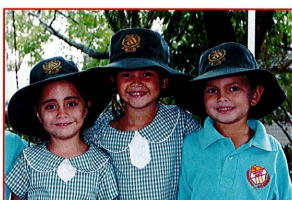
