Last week's panel visit was the culmination of many months of reflection, data gathering and evaluation by the staff and the input via survey from parents and carers (conducted earlier last term) was most appreciated.

As a result of the External Validation process, we have some clear directions for 2018 and are keen to share these and receive feedback at the Parents as Partners session on Friday. Some of our key areas of focus in 2018-20 include: enhancing student wellbeing, improving student learning in literacy and numeracy and developing future focussed learning. 


Stage 1/2/3 Numeracy LST Group
