Principal's Report

It has been a busy fortnight with students participating in the NAPLAN assessments which will finish on Friday with a few makeup tests. Overall the technology worked well, although we did have some hiccups with the sound. Congratulations to Year 3 and Year 5 in their behaviour with this assessment.

School continues to be a busy site with many activities occurring. Our K-2 students have been walking to their Gymnastics sessions, which I joined them at this week. The program is energetic and has the students learning and developing many skills which simply could not be done at school. This is a great resource that the school is able to access. Our bike program is going well too. Last week we were in the local newspaper and we are appearing in another article for the Department of Education. This program will run until the second last week of term 2.

Next week will see the K-4 students engage with the Sporting Schools Australia program which provides funding to conduct different sports with expert coaches. NSW Hockey are sending a coach to work with the classes for a 40 min session each week across 4 weeks. K,1 and 2 will have their sessions on Thursday while Years 3 and 4 will start after scripture on a Tuesday. 5/6 are going to participate in a sporting program for Ultimate Frisbee on a Monday from 30 May.

School Maintenance

The school has seen a lot of upgrades and improvements recently. This has been continuing with the repainting of 5/6W's demountable, which is now a much brighter and inviting room. 1C's demountable is also being repainted which will see the class move to the Library for a short period.

The construction of covered walkways will begin in June, beginning. They will start the construction of the walkways in June and the program will continue until August. There is 320 metres of walkways to build but in the end students and staff will be able to reach all areas of the school under cover.
