#### **Principal's Report**

This week has been a busy one indeed. We have had several people in the grounds looking at upgrades and installations which are occurring or preparing to occur. Pleasingly the Library demountable building arrived in sections last week and was placed on the piers. This is now being fitted out with carpets and shelving. We should be able to move into the new Library from Term 2. More exciting news has been given on further ground improvements for resurfacing the lower playground and walkways around the buildings. This will remove the trip hazards and address some of the flooding issues, including putting guttering along the edge of the field to direct the water to the drains rather than across the playground. A discussion was also had with regard to covered walkways expanding to all areas of the school which is very promising.

This week the School Interview Booking site was opened for Parents and Carers to make appointments. This is a great opportunity to meet with your child and teacher to discuss progress and set goals. #### Installation of School Zone Flashing Lights at Miranda North School

Transport for NSW has confirmed that new Zone Flashing Lights will be installed in the 40km/h school zone by 14 April 2022, at our school and Endeavour Sports High. The two existing static signs will be replaced with Flashing Light signs to improve visibility for road users and the community improving road safety.

#### **Bike Program**

The Stage three Bike program is coming up. The program will run throughout Term 2 on Fridays and will help to develop safe bike riding knowledge and practices. The P&C are supporting this program with the donation of 3 bikes. Frasers Cycles on Taren Point Road have very generously given their support to the program. A Parent information Session will be held on Zoom in Term 2 with the program coordinator.
